He was our project director and lead community organizer who successfully secured a grant for our organization to engage the Hmong community in organizing and advocacy work to gain access to public services and narrow the gap between the police and the Hmong community. He did an excellent job at it which resulted with the hiring of a Hmong speaking staff at the local public housing authority. Yang has the ability to quickly and easily learn how to use various software products and troubleshoot to resolve computer issues. In our family, Yang is our IT person who is able to connect all of us via video conference, group phone conference, and via other technologies that even though we all live far from each other, we can still easily be in touch.
